



- They are not aware of the local area and its services
- They lack personal attachment to local surroundings.






Hyperlocal information

- Relevant to small communities or neighbourhoods
- Both functional and emotional
- Often not referenced by location







- Participants were interested to hear local news and official announcements

Creating tasks for teens

- Brainstorming with a group of 5 teenagers
- Interviewing 2 teachers
- Six tasks for the students, aged 13-14 years old



Field studies with teenagers

- Total of 86 teenagers (13-14 years old), in five different schools
- 1,5 hour session
- Students went to nearby forests or parks
- After tasks with #hylo, a short discussion and a questionnaire








